Dear Parent,

Thank you for your cooperation and patience throughout our first two rounds of H1N1 vaccination clinics. The Bucks County Department of Health with the cooperation of all Bucks County School Districts has provided immunizations to over 60,000 people.

The Bucks County Department of Health would now like to open clinics for all Bucks County residents.

In addition, any child under 10 who needs their 2nd dose of the vaccine will be eligible to receive it at the clinics listed below. Please wait until at least 21 days from when your child received their first H1N1 vaccine to get the 2nd dose.

Similarly to the clinics in December, we will ask for contact information and consent for your child at the actual clinic; therefore, no child under 18 years of age will be able to receive a vaccination without a parent present.

While these clinics are not restricted to any specific school districts, they are for **Bucks County residents only**. Please bring appropriate identification, and attend the clinic most convenient for you:
